| Curriculum Design | The curriculum is designed so that children learn about their own locality, the UK and then the wider world in each phase. Learning is split into different overarching themes | Science is organised into discrete blocks, with knowledge being built over time by returning to key concepts e.g plants, animals including humans etc. | History is split into two strands in KS2: British History and World History. Overarching concepts and themes are then studied in Y6. The foundations of KS2 study are established in EYs and KS1. | Geography is used to provide location and background for studying history in KS2. History and geography dovetail to give a sense of time and place. EYS/KS1 provides the background for further study | Aspects of RE are blocked so that children can gain a deeper understanding of a particular faith or religion within a particular year group. Christianity is visited regularly throughout. | Key skills are developed progressively across school, examining areas such as drawing, painting and sculpture. | Keys skills are developed progressively and pupils revisit key strands of DT throughout KS1 and KS2. All year groups study food technology. | Languages have been studied from Y1 onwards. This stopped in Sept 2022 and so a new plan will be in place for September 2023 for the new y3 class. The language curriculum links to wider curriculum themes where possible, with each unit being standalone, although there are elements of progression in skills e.g. counting. | Computing is delivered as a discrete subject, using a spiral curriculum where key skills are introduced and built upon over time. | Music is blocked up to ensure that adequate time is given for children to learn and apply new skills. Some year groups have enhancements to the curriculum through specialist music tuition – recorders, ukulele, singing | PSHE is delivered as a discrete subject, using a spiral curriculum where key skills are introduced and built upon over time. | PE is delivered as a discrete subject, using a spiral curriculum where key skills are introduced and built upon over time. | Every half term, specific elements of school's ethos and values are promoted through the curriculum content being delivered.
